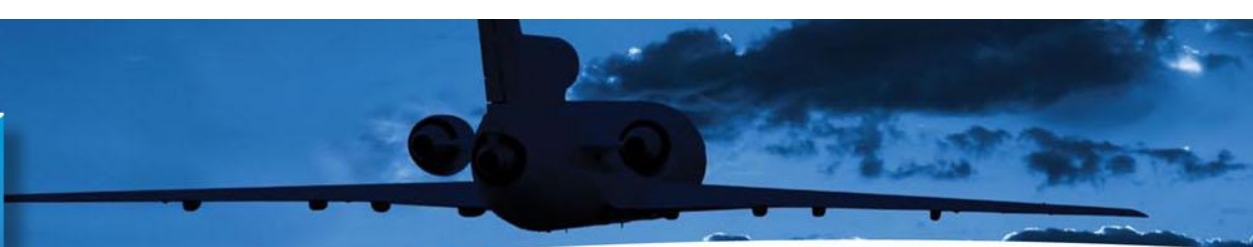

Course Overview

Distance Learning study involves continuous assessment of student progress through the specially tailored PTC software contained on the ATPL Digital DVD. Your test performance will be recorded, sent through to us and assessed. In addition, the course includes access to an active ATPL discussion forum and the PTC Study Student Portal. This website includes a study diary, supporting documentation, and self-assessment tests.

Each student is required to attend a pre exam revision course at PTC, Waterford, Ireland or in Melbourne, Florida, USA as part of the overall JAA Course Requirements. The Consolidation Course is led by our Chief Ground Instructor, and a JAA/ IAA approved team of highly trained and experienced ground instructors.

Instructor support on specific subjects is available in the classroom, via email, the PTC Forum, the ATPL Student Portal, by phone or in person.
