# JAA/EASA Commercial Pilots Licence (SEP/CPL) (A)

## WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE?

If you hold an ICAO PPL and you have completed the JAA/EASA ATPL or CPL Theoretical Knowledge examinations and gained the necessary flight experience, this course will guide you through the Commercial training for issue of a Commercial Pilots Licence (Aeroplane). (Ref: JAR-FCL 1.150)

The Privilege of the holder of a CPL (A) is to act as:

- Pilot-in-command or co-pilot of any aeroplane engaged in operations other than commercial air transportation.
- Pilot-in-command in commercial air transportation of any Single Pilot Aeroplane (SPA)
- Co-pilot in commercial air transportation

## Entry requirements

Before commencing JAA/EASA Commercial Pilots Licence course, candidates will require the following experience and qualifications:

- English Language proficiency to at least ICAO Level 4 will be required before licence issue.
- JAA Class 1 Medical Certificate.
- Hold a ICAO PPL(A) with night qualification or rating (see below)
- Have completed 170 hours flight time as a pilot of which 100 hours must be as Pilot in Command. (Total 200hrs before licence issue). (See JAR-FCL 1.155).
- Have passed the JAA/EASA theoretical knowledge examinations for CPL (A) or ATPL (A).
- Have completed 300nm qualifying cross country flight
- Have completed the 5 hours night flying requirement including the 5 solo night take offs and landings.

## Fees

The course fee of **£6,602** includes the following items::

- Regulatory flight and ground training
- Access to all learning materials and equipment
- Licence and rating issue fees for JAA Commercial Pilots Licence
- Examiner fees for Skill test
- Aircraft Rental for flight tests
- Student email and *e-learning* materials

Not included in fee:

Landing/Approach fees at other airfields at cost.  
Additional training will be charged at current PTC aircraft rates.
