WHO SHOULD DO THIS MODULAR COURSE?

If you hold a JAA PPL (A) and/or a JAA CPL (A), this course will guide you through the training course for the issue of a Multi Engine Piston Class (Aeroplane) rating.

The MEP (A) will allow you to exercise the privileges of your PPL (A)/CPL (A) on a Multi-Engine Piston Class of aircraft.

*Note: Minimum Flight hours may be insufficient for standard required for issue of Certificate of Competence

Entry requirements

Before commencing the MEP Class rating course, applicants will require the following qualifications:

- English Language proficiency to at least ICAO Level 4
- JAA Class 1/2 Medical Certificate
- Hold a JAA PPL(A) /CPL (A) with night qualification or rating
- PPL (A) holders need to produce evidence of having completed 70 hours Pilot-in-Command.(JAR-FCL 1.260)
