



Instrument Rating (IR) Revalidation and Renewal.

Who should do this course?

The IR revalidation is intended for those who wish to retain their instrument rating.

If your IR has expired we can also renew your IR combined with your Multi Engine Piston (MEP) rating with a skills test in an aircraft.

Course Overview

Revalidations can be completed on the FNPTII simulator. Proficiency check and exam preparation are completed in a single day with the exam taking place on the following day. The proficiency check takes 1.5 hours to complete and is carried out by a senior instructor who will agree with you how many simulator hours preparation you need in order to prepare for the exam.

While an FNPTII is used in the first instance for the proficiency check, at least each alternate IAA Examination Flight for IR revalidation is performed in an aircraft. We would recommend in this circumstance that the preparation training is conducted both on the FNPT II and in the aircraft.

Renewal of an IR and an MEP rating can be examined by a single flight test. Preparation involves a proficiency check with a senior instructor who will agree a preparation programme with you.

Entry requirements

- JAA Class 1 Medical
- PPL(A) or CPL(A) or ATPL(A) containing an IR(A)
- Completed enrolment form

Fees

The cost of the IR Revalidation may vary depending on your particular circumstance and how you perform in the proficiency test.

The hourly rate for multi-engine flight training is €485.

The hourly rate for the FNPTII is €180*.

*This is a special rate which applies to revalidation and renewals only.

Fees not included:

- Any additional training hours outside of regulatory requirements or any costs associated with repeat examinations
- Accommodation
- Airport charges and fuel surcharges
- Exam and examiner fees
- Licence issue
