



Why should I do this course?

The instructor programme has many benefits for those who hold a current

JAA CPL (A):

- Qualifies a Licensed Pilot to provide Instruction and training for the grant of a JAA PPL and once unrestricted to CPL.
- Allows pilots to build up flight hours and experience before transition to an airline or continuing as a Career Instructor
- Keeps your CV current and adds real aviation and flight experience
- A valuable qualification when applying for positions as airline training first officer or captain and examiner (TRI, TRE).

Course Overview

The course duration is 5 weeks including skills test. Training is provided at the PTC Training Centre in Melbourne, Florida, USA. Before enrolment, the applicant will complete a pre entry flight test and assessment.

The course consists of a 15 hour self-study module, 110 hours of ground school training, 30 hours of flight instruction training, progress checks and an instructor skills tests. During the ground training, the student will practice giving ground lectures in theoretical subjects. There will be at least 5 hours of progress checks with an FIC instructor during ground training.

The flight training element of this course consists of 30 hours instructor training of which 5 hours may be mutual flying (that is 2 candidates flying together to practice flight demonstrations).

On satisfactory completion of the FI rating course, the candidate will undergo an Instructor Skills Test with a Flight Instructor Examiner (FIE). The contents of the test consist of a theoretical knowledge oral, pre-flight briefing, a flight, post flight debriefing, result and candidate debrief.

JAA Flight Instructor Programme

Entry requirements

- JAA CPL(A) or
- JAA PPL(A) with at least 200 hrs flight time of which 150 are PIC with FAA endorsement or hold a valid FAA PPL
- JAA SEP class rating
- JAA class 1 medical
- 5 hrs single engine time in the last 6 months
- Pre-course entry flight test
- Personal finance plan
- Complete enrolment form

Fees

The cost of the JAA Flight Instructor Programme is €7,500 which is payable in two instalments:

- €500– on enrolment
- €7,000 – 30 days before course start date

Fees included

Ground Training

- 15 hours self-study
- 25 hrs Teaching and Learning Module
- 20 hrs Supervised Practice Instruction
- 30 hrs FI Ground School Practise
- 30 hrs Dual Tuition
- 5 hrs Progress Checks with FIC

Flight Training

- 25 hrs flight instruction dual
- 5 hrs mutual instructor training

Not included

- Skills test with FIE
- IAA Fees
- Aircraft rental for test
- Accommodation
- Travel Costs
- Additional training that may be required outside the regulatory hours requirement depending on student progress.
