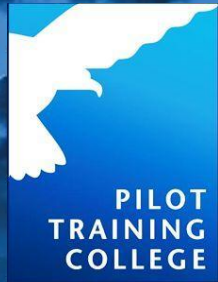


# JAA Integrated Airline Pilot Training Programme



## WHO SHOULD DO THIS COURSE?

The Integrated Airline Pilot Training Programme is designed for those who want the most effective and intensive route to a career in aviation. The course takes just 15 months to complete and is designed for students who no previous flying experience.

## WHY SHOULD I CHOOSE PILOT TRAINING COLLEGE?

Pilot Training College is a JAA certified flight training organisation with training centres in Ireland (JAA IRL/FTO-005-03) and USA (JAA IRL/FTO-009-08). We train and produce 'Airline Ready' graduates through world class training and instruction. ### Pilot Training College – Florida Training Centre

The Training Centre in the USA is located at Melbourne International Airport, Florida. Student accommodation is on the Florida Institute of Technology (FIT) campus giving student pilots access to the best that the US college experience has to offer including sports facilities, restaurants, library and other opportunities for personal development. The campus is located on the 'Space Coast' close to NASA's Kennedy Space Centre. The training location offers nearly 300 days a year of near perfect Visual Flight Rules (VFR) training conditions.

### Pilot Training College – Waterford Training Centre

The Training Centre in Ireland is based at Waterford Regional Airport in the south-east of Ireland. It is one of the best locations for pilot training in Europe due to freely available airspace, Waterford Airport being ideally equipped for instrument flight training (IFR), no taxi, slot or approach delays and seven days-a-week operations. The Training Centre is purpose built and includes a Mechtronix FNPTII simulator, student briefing rooms, classrooms, canteen, crew room and a student services department.

## ADDITIONAL COURSE INFORMATION

Applicants must be a minimum age of 17 years of age on joining the course in order to meet the age qualifications for licences and ratings.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

Before commencing integrated training, candidates will require the following qualifications:

- 5 passes in General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE)
- Level C or above; Leaving Certificate (3Cs) or other equivalent qualification.
- Satisfactory completion of the PTC pilot skills and aptitude assessment test and other selection procedures.
- English Language proficiency to at least ICAO Level 4 (conversational level English) will be required before licence issue.
- JAA Class 1 Medical Certificate. Our admissions department will advise on the most efficient process for booking your medical appointment.

## FEES:

The total cost of the course is €97,950 payable in five instalments. The first instalment of €3,500 is made in order to confirm your place. There are three other instalments each of €25,000 and a final instalment of €19,450.

The course fee is an all inclusive programme which includes the following items: Regulatory flight and ground training (*including Multi Crew Co-operation and Jet Orientation course*)

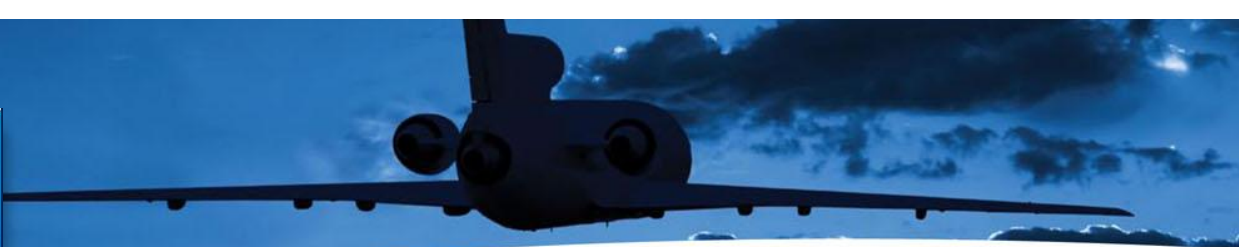

## COURSE OVERVIEW

This full-time course follows a high quality, airline training curriculum that is designed to be completed in approximately 15 months. ## COURSE STRUCTURE

Phase	Centre	Training
Basic Training I	Florida	Initial aircraft handling skills and first solo flight
Basic Training II*	Florida	Basic principles of navigation with solo flights to airfields further away from the training centre. This culminates in the award of an FAA Private Pilots Licence (PPL)
Intermediate Training*	Florida	Refined flying skills to the level required by a commercial pilot. Transition from single engine to multi-engine aircraft.
Advanced Instrument Training	Waterford	Flying an aircraft within cloud relying on flight instruments only, culminating in the award of a JAA Commercial Pilots Licence with Multi Engine Instrument Rating
Multi-Crew Cooperation Training	Dublin	Transition from training environment to the operation of larger multi crew jet and turbo prop aircraft.

*\*The ATPL Theoretical Knowledge training in preparation for the fourteen written exams is delivered in parallel with the Basic Training II and Intermediate Training.*
