



Who should do this course?

The JAA Private Pilot Licence (PPL) is the first step in your aviation career. Upon course completion, you will be qualified to fly a single engine piston, fixed wing aircraft for non-commercial purposes under visual flying rules. This course is designed for beginners with no flying experience who wish to start flying for recreational purposes or on a career path toward becoming a commercial airline pilot.

The JAA PPL course is completed in Weston Executive Airport, Leixlip, Co Kildare and the qualification is awarded by the Irish Aviation Authority. If your ultimate goal is to become a commercial pilot the JAA PPL Licence can be put towards your required hours and training for the JAA frozen Airline Transport Pilots licence (fATPL).

Who we are?

SkyTrace is the Dublin Training Centre for Pilot Training College. It is an Irish Aviation Authority (IAA) Registered Training Facility (RTF). The IAA is a member of the European Aviation Safety Authority (EASA), which is the centrepiece of the European Union's strategy for aviation safety. Here we specialise in recreational flying and training to Private Pilots Licence standard.

Course overview

The PPL course consists of a minimum of 45 flight training hours, comprising of a minimum of 25 dual hours and 10 supervised solo hours. Your flight training will take place in a modern single engine aircraft, and will comprise of flight manoeuvres including takeoffs and landings, navigation and emergency operations. Combined with the flight training hours you will sit 70 hours of ground instruction to prepare for the written Private Pilot Licence Theoretical Knowledge Examinations.

Upon successful completion of both the written exam and the PPL flight test you will receive a JAA Private Pilot Licence.



JAA Private Pilot Licence

Entry requirements

- Completed Enrolment Form
- Copy of Passport
- Deposit of €200

Fees:

- The cost of the JAA PPL course is €9,950 which can be paid on a **Pay as You Fly** basis or in instalments.

Fees include:

- 45 flight training hours
- Long Briefs
- 70 hours Theoretical Knowledge Group Ground School.

Fees not included:

- Class 2 Medical
- Student Pilot Licence
- PPL Theoretical Knowledge examination Fees
- Aircraft rental for flight test
- Flight Test Fee
- Any additional training hours outside of regulatory requirements or any costs associated with repeat examinations
- Professional pilot equipment
- Books, manuals and learning material
- Airport charges and fuel surcharges at current rates .
